

STATISTICS

- 15,000 community visitors to CREEC (Canning River Eco Education Centre)
- 6000+ students from 98 primary and secondary schools across Perth participated in CREEC's environmental education programs.
- 530 primary school students and 21 environmental organisations celebrated International Earth day in April at CREEC.
- 120 children participated in the Cockatoo Kids Club.
- 80 early childhood educators supported by 'Little Green Steps' program.
- 16,000 plants planted in re-vegetation projects at numerous conservation sites during 2014/15.

"Support and collaborate with organisations working to provide sustainability education within the community."

"Support provided to early childhood educators to embed more sustainable practices in early learning setting (i.e. daycare, kindergarten). The City sponsored a six month pilot program, Little Green Steps, which was delivered by the Australian Association for Environmental Education WA in partnership with the City's Sustainability Team."



"Encourage and demonstrate sustainability within the City."

"The City developed a draft Climate Change Action Plan, a Sustainable Built Form Working Group and has a Sustainable Energy (Utility Revolving) Fund to fund renewable energy projects, water and energy efficiency measures."



"Support and encourage environmental community groups who are active in achieving this goal (goal: to protect, preserve and promote our natural places, flora and fauna)."

"A wetland constructed jointly between the City's engineers and the community group 'Friends of Queens Park Bushland'. Stormwater was harvested from the site and piped into a wetland and the Friends group provided plants and re-vegetation works."
